Road Trip 2011 (Doug & Brenda Bowers)

Our epic journey began 8: am, 6 September 2011. With trunk and saddle bags full of clothes, weather gear, Room Saver, and Gold Book, we were on our way. Once through the border it was a quick trip to Longview Wa then west to the Oregon Coast that we heard so much about, it's rugged beauty is breath taking. Our first stop for the night was Tillamook Or, which wouldn't be complete without a tour of the Cheese Factory. After stocking up on the local cheese, we were on our way. The U.S. 101 through Oregon is truly amazing with plenty of stops for viewing. From there, we set our sights on California.

Our first stop in California was the Inspection Station where it was determined that the oranges from our last continental breakfast were indeed California oranges. We left the 101 and turned onto California 1 north of Fort Bragg. Wow! what a nice road, it's in perfect shape and has plenty of twist and turns to satisfy every riding ability. On to San Francisco. Make sure you have \$6 US cash ready at the south end of the Golden Gate Bridge. With no inexpensive lodging in San Fran, we moved on back to Cal 1. One of the highlights on the way south was the tour of Hearst Castle, truly opulent and amazing. We continued on Cal 1down the coast through LA to San Diego. We walked to Old Town where we took a guided trolley tour throughout San Diego, a truly beautiful city.

We set our sights east to Arizona, first, Yuma then Tucson, liked Tucson so much we stayed there 3 days, should have stayed at Motel 6, it was only \$175 a week. A side trip to Tombstone was a must. The whole town is a museum with it's saloons, court house and of course the Gun fight at the OK Corral, Boot Hill, we learned that the gentleman running the stagecoach tour was from Timmins On. Our next stop was Phoenix, I choose a motel in the north end because it was close to the GWRRA home office. A tour of the office was arranged and we were introduced to everyone. What a talented, hard working group that give us the GWRRA. We were north bound to get out of the 107 F heat, through Sedona to Flagstaff. We were awed by the natural wonders such as the Meteor crater and the south rim of the Grand Canyon.

On the list was Route 66 and lunch at the Road Kill Café in Seligman AZ, followed soon by Kingman, Laughlin, Lake Mead, Hoover Dam and a few days in Las Vegas. It was back to California through the Mojave Desert to Bakersfield then north to Oakhurst. From there we took advantage

of a guided tour of Yosemite National Park which was well worth the price. The next leg of the journey was to the Napa Valley and the town of Calistoga which is a spa town, every hotel has hot pools which are fed by natural hot springs.

We kept our eyes on the weather forecasts up the coast and home, we knew the rains were on their way so we winged our way back to Fort Bragg on the coast. The trip north on the Oregon Coast was better with sunny skies and no fog. We encountered only 20 minutes of rain the entire trip. On the 9th of October and over 8500 kms, we were back home late in the afternoon. The people we encountered were friendly and courteous and we gave it right back to them. The loaded down Wing performed without a hitch, just as it was designed to do.

Would we do it again? Absolutely.


T. E. Lawrence, better known as Lawrence of Arabia, owned several of these machines and died from his injuries after crashing on one in 1935...

I just found them slight too aggressive for me when I'm doing Top Gun maneuvers with the bike at full steering lock and maximum lean angle while dragging the rear brake. This would not be an issue for the average ride. I paid \$165 + TAX and would like to get \$75 for the set.
