

2013-2014 Winter maintenance; Part 1 by John Schretlen

Winter maintenance. It means different thing to different riders and at a fall BC-A breakfast I was asked what my plans were. Actually it was worded a bit differently, more like "When is a good time for me to bring my bike over for a fluid change?" but nevertheless it was a decent question.

At the time my bike was already taken apart so the lift table would be busy for another month and helping a fellow BC-A rider would have to wait a bit. But before I go into that let's back up. My 2013 winter maintenance involved some not-normally-scheduled items. I'll start my story with my last two days of riding in 2013. Both were with the company of BC-A members.

The second-to-last day was a ride to Tumwater, Washington with Donn C. who was getting a new low profile windshield. As I pulled into the dealer's shop area my left turn signal decided to stop working. Hmmm. While Donn was getting his new windshield installed I did some troubleshooting. I located a popped breaker so replaced it and all was well on the ride home, until I used my turn signal and again it failed.

That night I did some more troubleshooting and did not find any reason why the c/b kept popping but I wanted to go on Chuck T's ride-in-the-fog early the next morning so I decided that if I did not use the turn signals everything would be fine. Do you have any idea how hard it is to NOT use the turn signals? My c/b popped before I got to the Blaine Chevron. It was a great ride but I broke off about 1:00 pm to head for home and start troubleshooting this snag in more depth. It would be the start of my winter maintenance.

First thing I did was put some gas stabilizer in the tank and ride around UBC to make sure it is well mixed. When I got home I drained the oil and fogged up the cylinders. Okay – ready for a long winter sit so now I'll get to the turn signal problem.

I did all the normal tests as per the maintenance manual and the ETG (Electronic Troubleshooting Guide) manual. It was looking like the turn signal unit was faulty but it is hard to get at so I wanted to check my wire bundles first to make sure I did not have a short or kinked wire.

Early Monday morning I was in North Van at Tayormotive borrowing a short finder (Thanks again Chuck). Unfortunately all my wire bundles tested normal. I say 'unfortunately' because that meant getting at that turn signal unit. On the 2002 that unit is behind the instruments panel. To get at it you need to take off the windshield, the mirrors, the plastic and metal on the front of the bike under the windshield and only then can you get at the bolts holding the instrument cluster. Eventually I got the instrument panel out and taken apart to reveal the turn signal unit.

That night I put in an order for a new turn signal unit and, since I was ordering an OEM part, I decided to order a new right handlebar switch cluster. My cruise on-off button has been acting up for a few years now and I've cleaned it a half dozen times but it was getting worse. Honda will not sell individual switches so I had to buy the whole cluster.

Note: if anybody needs any of the other switches from the right had cluster I can give you some gently used ones. **To be continued**...


