



Rider Education information online from Rider educators Bob & Becky Minor

The Rider Education Database is now available to Members. Now you as a member can find out just where you are in the Rider Education Levels Program, without the need to go to your Chapter Educator. The database is read only to you, but your chapter educator can help if you find that your data is not correct.

"This site is meant for the membership to check and track their GWRRA Rider Education Levels status, riding courses and seminar information. If you find any discrepancies in your information please get in touch with your Chapter Educator or Leadership Trainer to correct the error."

Read below to understand how to access it.

Once you get to the GWRRA.org website, click on either Officers or Programs from the blue menu bar to view a drop down menu. "Click on "Rider Education".

On the left side of the main Rider Ed page (the index page) you will see a new button for

"My R.E. Information"

Click on that button to follow the link to the login. You must be a current GWRRA member to login.

Username= Membership Number. ie. 123456 or 1234-01

Password= Numbers In Your Address + Membership Expiration Date (MMYY)

ie. 12 W. 6th st only 12 would be used followed by your membership expiration date.

ie. If your membership expiration date is 01/15 then your password would be 120115

Check the front of your Wing World or Membership card for your membership number and expiration date.

Once your Username and password are entered, click on "Submit" to see your individual record.

If you are the primary Member, you will be able to access the information for each of your family Members.


